**EIS Alerts Inspection Report April 2021**

The Bureau of Internal Oversight (BIO) Audits and Inspections Unit (AIU) will conduct inspections of the Early Identification System (EIS) Alerts monthly. The purpose of the inspection is to ensure compliance with Office Policies and to promote

proper supervision. To achieve this, the Court Appointed Monitor Team, through the Court Implementation Division, selected a sample of **15** EIS Alerts (or all if less than **15**) closed/completed during the month being inspected. These selected alerts were provided to the AIU. To ensure consistent inspections, the *EIS Alerts Inspection Matrix* developed by the AIU will be utilized.

#### Matrix Procedure:

Utilize the EIS Alerts Inspection Matrix to ensure that the selected EIS Alerts are returned to the Early Intervention Unit (EIU) in the required timeframe.

### Criteria:

MCSO Policy GB-2, *Command Responsibility*MCSO Policy GH-5, *Early Identification System* (EIS)

#### **Conditions:**

After AIU received the <u>15</u> closed EIS Alert cases selected by the Court Appointed Monitor Team, a review of the IAPro Early Identification case management system was conducted for each of the EIS Alerts in the provided sample.

Below are the inspection results for the 15 selected EIS Alerts completed/closed during April 2021:


